## Fall 2020

- March 27, 2020 - President Stanley announced that MSU will conduct courses both in-person and online.
- July 6, 2020 Federal government issued guidance
- Some limitations with online course requirements
- Unclear if students can maintain status outside of the U.S.
- Advocacy
- President Stanley "Our international students deserve better and we are demanding it on their behalf."
- Lawsuit
- MSU and Dr. McCallum Beatty were quoted in the brief


## MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY SPARTANS WILL.

## Fall 2020

- July 14, 2020 - Lawsuit was rescinded
- We revert back to the March guidance
- Returning students in the U.S. are eligible for online courses
- Returning students outside of the U.S. are eligible for all online courses
- Returning students can maintain status while outside of the U.S.
- Five-month Rule does not apply to students who maintain full-time enrollment

## Fall 2020 Enrollment

- Enroll full-time
- Continue to make progress towards completion of your program
- If fall is your final semester, notify OISS
- If you have no plans to return to the U.S. and will complete your studies outside of the U.S. notify OISS
- Check your MSU email daily, read and respond to emails
- If you are planning to travel, get a travel signature and work with OISS to discuss any travel challenges
